So, whether you choose the inboard, or outboard motor option, you'll be ready to take on your next adventure in perfect comfort.





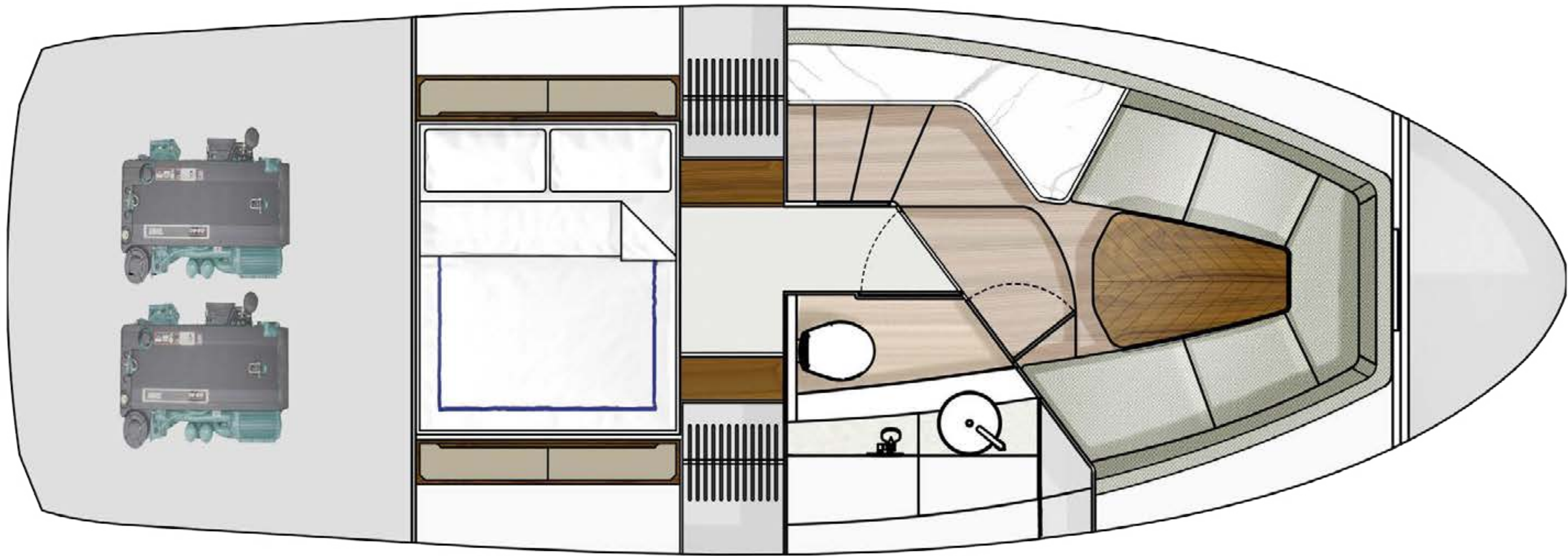
